PARENTS OF 9TH GRADERS:

Students entering high school face many educational challenges as they prepare for responsible adulthood. At least 80% of learning is mediated through vision. Impaired vision is one of the most common health problems affecting children. By high school graduation one third will have a vision problem requiring correction.

To assure that ninth graders have adequate vision to meet educational demands, Michigan Public Health Code, Act 368, recommends vision screening for ninth graders. To meet the screening needs of these students, the Oakland County Health Division offers free vision screening by appointment at the North Oakland Health Center and South Oakland Health Center locations.
