2014-2015 School Annual Education Report**

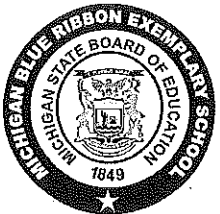

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2014-2015 educational progress for Children's Village School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability and teacher quality. Children's Village School is a K-12 school program that provides a broad range of educational services delivered by the Waterford School District via a contract with Oakland County. All teachers are highly qualified Waterford School District employees. All courses are fully accredited and transferable to home school districts. Students receive instruction in core subjects, aligned with the Michigan Merit Curriculum. Elective courses include music, physical education, art, business, and daily living skills. Students also have access to on-line credit recovery during the school day and/or after school. Student assistance is enhanced by the Title I reading and math programs, designed for students who are three or more years below grade level, which provides instruction that builds the student's current level of skills.



State law requires that we also report additional information.

PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL:

The school serves children in grades K-12 who have been adjudicated via the Probate Court for delinquency, neglect, truancy at home/school, or incorrigibility at home/school. These students come from all 28 school districts in Oakland County, other counties within the State of Michigan and occasionally out-of-state students.



THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN:



Children's Village School will continue to focus on the following school improvement goals:

- All students will become proficient in math.
- All students will improve their comprehensive reading skills.
- All students will improve their writing skills across the curriculum.
- All students will improve their behavior at Children's Village School.

A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL:

Kingsley Montgomery School (KMS), formerly known as Montgomery Developmental Training Center, is a segregated special education facility that provides support for severe cognitive impaired (SCI), severe multiply impaired (SXI), post-secondary cognitive impaired (MoCI), and severe emotionally impaired (SEI) students.

Children's Village School is a facility owned by Oakland County and operated by the Waterford School District. The school serves children in grades K-12 who have been adjudicated via the Probate Court for delinquency, neglect, truancy at home/school, or incorrigibility at home/school. These students come from all 28 school districts in Oakland County, other counties within the State of Michigan and also some out-of-State students.
