December 8, 2016, Waterford, Mich. – Oakland County Michigan Works! Waterford has been awarded \$38,000, on behalf of three local companies, from the Talent Investment Agency, Skilled Trades Training Fund (STTF), which will provide specific short term skilled training. Those companies are Jay Shop, Total Door, and The Productivity Team.

The STTF provides competitive awards for employer responsive training that enhances talent, productivity and employment retention while increasing the quality and competitiveness of Michigan's employers. The STTF ensures Michigan's employers have the talent they need to compete and grow, and individuals have the skills they need for in-demand jobs.
