Waterford Students Earn Prestigious Scholastic Art Awards

February 2, 2017, Waterford, Mich. – Waterford Kettering and Mott High School students' artwork was adjudicated into the 2017 Scholastic Art Awards Exhibit. Nearly 6,000 individual middle and high school entries and more than 200 senior portfolios were entered in 16 categories this year from Oakland, Lenawee, Livingston, Monroe, Washtenaw and Wayne Counties. Eleven Hundred individual category works and 101 portfolios were selected to receive American Vision, Gold Key, Silver Key and Honor Mention Awards.
