The Waterford Foundation Edward J. Kuhn Scholarship

The Edward J. Kuhn Scholarship was established to recognize scholastic achievement, to encourage continued progress, and to provide assistance to high school students in financing their education. Two \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded annually to one Kettering High School and one Mott High School deserving senior.

Eligibility Requirements and Criteria for Selection:

An applicant must be a Waterford School District high school graduating senior in good standing. Students may use the scholarship award for tuition and other educational expenses. The scholarship will be awarded to deserving students in the minds of the scholarship committee using the following criteria:

- Receive average grades of B and C
- Need financial help in order to enter college
- Exhibit outstanding character

High School Scholarship Committee Recommendations:

A list of eligible recipients shall be compiled annually by the faculty and staff of Waterford Kettering and Mott High Schools and submitted to a scholarship committee established at each high school. The committee will consist of three members: principal and two counselors. These individuals will make the selection of the final recipients, one from each high school. The committee, without regard to race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age or handicap, will make selection of final recipients. No student will be discriminated against on such basis.
