Tuition/Fees and Payment/Refunds

- All fees are listed by the course description. Tuition assistance may be available for students that meet specific academic requirements for some courses.
- Registrations can be completed online at www.wsdmi.org/learn or a registration form accompanied by a check, money order or credit card # **for the full amount of each class fee. No student will be allowed to attend a class until full payment has been made.**
- Checks should be made payable to the **Waterford School District**.

- **Requests for refunds will not be accepted after class begins.** A request for a refund must be made in writing to the Summer Academy Office at Durant High School. A service fee of \$25 is charged for all refunds except where classes are cancelled.
- **Classes will run only if there is sufficient enrollment.** If a class is cancelled, students will be notified before the class begins.

Attendance Policy

It is the purpose of the Waterford School District to create an environment where every person's behavior consistently ensures student success. There is a direct relationship between regular, punctual attendance and a quality learning experience. Education involves more than just completing assigned class work. To gain the maximum benefit of learning, students need to develop the self-discipline of attending class; participating in group, team, and laboratory activities; listening to the ideas, thoughts, and opinions of people of differing backgrounds and cultures; and contributing to class discussions. Therefore, it is essential that students learn that prompt, consistent attendance and responsible, meaningful participation are key characteristics of successful adults. Students are expected to complete all classwork/homework/assessments missed from being absent. High School students are required to attend the first and last days of each term.

Credit Reporting

Non-Waterford residents are responsible for reporting credit status to their home school. Waterford students' credits will be reported to the home school. Report cards will be available through the MISTAR Parent Portal. They will not be mailed home unless requested. Credit is awarded for a final grade of 70% (C) or better.

Code of Conduct

Student behavior must be in compliance with the Waterford Schools Code of Conduct. Students are expected to attend class each day. Due to the short time period of each session and intensive nature of the curriculum, appropriate classroom behavior is expected at all times. Students who interfere with the learning process will be removed from the class. Suspension for disciplinary reasons may result in being dropped from a class and losing credit. Refunds will not be made for disciplinary situations.

MIDDLE SCHOOL SUMMER ACADEMY

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MIDDLE SCHOOL SKILL BUILDING: LITERACY AND MATH

This class will be geared to the individual literacy needs of each student and who have completed grades 5-7. Reading and mathematical competencies not demonstrated during the current school year will determine the program of study for each student. Priority will be given to the skills and strategies that are aligned to the literacy and math state standards. Learning outcomes for reading include reading and writing for meaning, reading strategies, word study, and fluency, in a variety of formats and text structures. Learning outcomes for mathematics include computational skills, algebraic skills, and problem solving strategies.

The fee for this course is \$160.

MIDDLE SCHOOL TO HIGH SCHOOL: TRANSITION TO ALGEBRA

This class is designed for exiting 8th grade students (incoming 9th grade students) who are interested in sharpening their algebraic skills before beginning Algebra I at their high school. This course uses logic puzzles, problems, and explorations to help build students' mathematical ways of thinking from the concrete procedures of arithmetic to the abstract reason that success with algebra requires. Students who successfully complete this course are eligible for .5 elective credit on their high school transcript. This course runs daily from 8:00-11:30am from July 30-August 17 at Durant High School.

The fee for this course is \$160.

Lunch is provided at 11:30 and transportation to the nearest elementary school is available immediately following lunch.

HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER ACADEMY

The Summer Academy program offers the following courses for credit to students who have completed grades 9–12. Check your High School Course Catalog for course descriptions. The High School Course Catalog is available on the district website at www.waterford.k12.mi.us under *Current Students or Parents*. **Unless indicated otherwise, courses are intended for credit recovery only.**

Schedule of Days and Times: There will be a morning session and an afternoon session with lunch provided in between sessions. The courses actually scheduled will be based on enrollment. All classes offered during the AM/PM sessions are taught by highly qualified teachers in each subject area. Regular attendance is required during these sessions. No school on July 3 & 4.

The fee for High School Courses Term A and Term B for WSD Students is \$175/.5 credit. The fee for out of district students is \$200/.5 credit.

Registration in these courses is restricted to students who have attempted the course during the school year and failed to earn credit. The classes are computer-based with a certified teacher mentor. The learning goals, assignments and tests will be completed on the computer. These credit recovery classes are listed below. Courses are taken at the Durant Computer Lab and must be completed by the end of Summer Academy on July 26. No extensions will be granted.

****Exiting 9th grade students are NOT eligible to enroll in online credit recovery courses in math, science, or language arts. It is recommended that exiting 9th grade students who need credit recovery in these three core academic areas should enroll in classes led by a classroom instructor.**

Fees for Term C Online Credit Recovery Courses :

WSD Students: \$100/.5 credit

Out of District Students: \$125/.5 credit

Students working in the Durant Computer Lab are still expected to be present every day until their course is completed. Students who complete a course prior to the end of the session may enroll in another course. The average student takes anywhere from 35-40 hours to complete an online credit recovery class.
