Dear WSD Community,

The Waterford School District is committed to the health and safety of our students and staff. Over the past several days, concerns regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) have escalated. While there have been no confirmed cases of the Coronavirus in Michigan, we recognize the seriousness of the situation, and we are monitoring it closely.

WSD will continue to follow guidance from the Oakland County Health Division, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). In the meantime, we are taking extra precautions to keep our buildings clean and disinfected, focusing on frequently touched surfaces and bathrooms.

According to the CDC, the best prevention for the Coronavirus, and any other viruses, such as the cold or flu, is to:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
