

Scholarship Tips

Most of the large scholarships are awarded by the colleges and universities themselves. To improve college scholarship opportunities, submit college admissions applications in the early fall of senior year. Contact the financial aid office of each college to learn what scholarship opportunities may be available.

Plan to take the ACT more than once.

Consider searching for scholarships to be a new part-time job. Stop by the Mott College and Career Center often to use resources and see if any new scholarship listings are available. Listings are typically provided on a monthly basis October-April.
