### HEAD SIZE REQUIREMENTS:

#### Yearbook Portrait:

1 1/4" from top of the head to the chin

#### Class Composite:

We will be using the same photo that is being submitted for the yearbook.

### BACKGROUND COLOR:

Old Masters Blue-Grey

### PICTURE SIZE REQUIREMENTS:

#### Yearbook Portrait:

2 1/8" wide x 2 5/8" long

#### Professional Digital Photos on CD or DVD only

- \*Must be above 300 D.P. I.
- \*File must be named with last name and first name of student.
- \*Student name **MUST** be written on the CD or DVD itself or on a case.
- \*We **DO NOT** accept emailed senior pictures

### COLOR PICTURES:

- Indoor color portrait from an established photography studio.
- No polaroid, print, or non-professional digital computer pictures.
- No shocking blue backgrounds or props.
- Backgrounds **MUST** be a professional canvas material. Painted walls, blankets, muslins, etc. will not be accepted.
- No writing on photo (class of..., studio name, etc.)

### APPEARANCE:

- Wear colors that stand out on a blue-gray background.
- Women's dress clothes such as pressed shirts, suits, and dress sweaters.
- Men's dress clothes including pressed shirts, ties, suits, jackets, and dress sweaters.

### HEAD AND SHOULDER VIEW:

- Frontal face view 3/4 face view in left or right direction with both eyes showing.
- Head and Shoulder view.
- Nose on cheek.

### SENIOR STATUS:

Students **must** have senior status by August in order to have their portraits placed in the senior section.

### PHOTOGRAPHY STUDIO:

Unique Image Studio of Photography, 6129 Highland Road, Waterford, MI 48327, telephone (248) 666-8907, is the official recommended school portrait studio because of their quality and uniformity in meeting yearbook standards. They are located near the corner of Airport Road and Highland Road (M-59)

### CLASS COMPOSITE:

A photograph of all the seniors who have submitted class composite portraits is available to purchase at registration. The yearbook staff is responsible for creating the class composite. The digital photo submitted to be in the yearbook will also be used for the class composite.
