





Guide to Viewing Grades on the Parent Portal

Log in to the Parent Portal.

- Middle School students receive grades in the **Marks** area at the end of each marking period. High school students receive grades in the **Marks** area at the end of each semester. Middle and high school students are given an academic letter grade in each class.
- Elementary students in Grades K - 5 receive numerical scores to indicate progress toward standards. In addition, elementary students in grades 3 - 5 receive academic letter grades for Mathematics, Science and Social Studies.
