# Program Descriptions

In response to the needs of families, the Waterford School District provides a variety of high quality preschool programs.

## Head Start

This is a free program for three and four-year old children of Waterford School District residents whose family income is at or below the poverty level. Children attend class four mornings or afternoons a week.

Registration is May 26 through May 29 and June 15, 2009 from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

## Preschool Enrichment Program (PEP) Achieving Preschool Excellence (APEX)

PEP and APEX are free programs funded by the Michigan Department of Education and are offered to four-year-olds who meet certain criteria such as low family income, single parent families, and family history of school failure. Children attend class four mornings or afternoons a week. Registration is May 26 through May 29 and June 15, 2009 from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. **Call (248) 666-4811 to schedule a registration appointment.**

## Tuition-based Preschool

Families who do not qualify for Head Start, PEP, or APEX should apply for the Tuition-based Preschool Program located at the Stepanski Early Childhood Center and several elementary buildings throughout the District.

Children turning four years old on or before December 1, 2009 will attend classes on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings or afternoons. Parents may also select a four day afternoon option. Children who are three years old on or before December 1, 2009 will attend classes on Tuesday and Thursday mornings or afternoons. Starting and ending times vary by location.

Tuition for this program ranges from \$672 to \$1,540 per year according to length of class and the number of classes per week. Registration for this program is handled by mail and classes are filled on a first-come basis according to postmark. **To register you must request a registration packet by calling the Preschool Office at (248) 666-9593.**
