Available for Waterford School District children who will be four by December 1, 2009 and meet **two** of the following criteria:

- Single parent household
- Language deficiency or immaturity
- Family history of low school achievement or dropout
- Lack of stable support system of residence
- Family history of diagnosed family problems
- Low family income
- Substance abuse or addiction
- Diagnosed handicapping conditions
- Other conditions (Health and/or Educational Concerns, Family Issues) which could affect learning.
