

## Suggested Supply Lists For 2011-2012

### First/Second Grade Multiage Classroom

- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 containers of Clorox wipes
- 1 container of hand soap
- 2 boxes of Ticonderoga pencils
- 4 duo tang folders with paper fasteners
- (red, blue, green, yellow – one of each)
- 1 spiral bound one-subject notebook
- 1 pair children's scissors - Fiskars if possible (to share with class)
- 8 glue sticks (to share with class)
- 1 box of crayons (to share with class)
- 1 box of markers (to share with class)
- \$4.50 for yearly *Scholastic News* subscription
- gym shoes (clean, to be kept at school)
- **Please DO NOT send in pencil boxes!**

### First Grade

- 2 Expo Dry Erase Markers
- Crayons 120 count (Target \$5.99. Sale priced at \$5.00)
- 6 glue sticks
- Scissors - Fiskars if possible
- 2 spiral bound notebook (wide ruled, 70 sheets)
- 4 Duo tang folders with pockets and brads (1 of each color- red, blue, green, yellow) plastic if possible
- 1 box of facial tissue
- 2 containers of Clorox disinfectant wipes
- 1 box of Ticonderoga Pencils
- Pencil box (plastic ones are the best)
