






Pontiac Lake Entrance – Created secure vestibule, installed new cement, replaced old classroom entrance with new stairs (right side), removed overgrown landscaping











Della Lutes Information

- The building has been leased to New Gateways since 2015.
- The lease is for 10 years (Nov 2015 Oct 2025).
- The contract has a non-binding option for 10 more years.
- The district nets approximately \$50,000 \$100,000/year after expenses.
- Annual assessments called for roof repairs of \$603,500 in 2022 and \$255,800 in 2023. They have been delayed.
- Exterior building assessment has \$43,000 for high-priority repairs and \$309,210 for medium-priority repairs.
- 2015 appraisal for the land is \$122,500. A new appraisal costs \$5,000.

Waterford Senior Center Update

- The Waterford Senior Center's (WSC) mission is "Assisting the needs of all the seniors within the community."
- The Senior Center has been part of WSD for 50 years.
- Programs offer a variety of activities for area seniors:
 - Social, recreational, health, fitness, and educational programs;
 - Waterford's Meals-on-Wheels program which serves nearly 80,000 homebound and 10,000 congregate meals annually;
 - Encore adult day service program has served Oakland County for 35 years.
- The programs have become self-sufficient through grants, service fees, donations, and fundraising.

Waterford Senior Center Update

It is a good time to move the WSC from WSD to the Waterford Twp.

- Preschool programs in Leggett are moving to Stepanski for 2024-25.
- The WSC is now self-sufficient within their programs
- Leggett could be used by the WSC until space is available or in place of other Twp. locations.
 - Built in 1956 as an elementary, the building was remodeled in 2002. It has been maintained by WSD.
 - The site offers 36,000 SF and 9.3 acres for Twp. use.
