

Ron and Barbara Newman Vocational Trades Scholarship 2026

The Vocational Trades Scholarship was established to recognize students achieving in trades and vocational careers. The scholarship is to provide assistance to students entering the trades and helping with financial needs for the program. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded annually to one student at Mott High School and one student at Kettering High School. The scholarship will assist with registration fees, material, tools and other needs for the program.

Eligibility Requirements and Criteria for Selection:

- An applicant must be in the Waterford School District High Schools graduating with a high school diploma.
 - Student must use the trades scholarship award to enter into any trades program including but not limited to, plumbing, electrical, construction, heating and cooling and welding.

Requirements:

- On track to receive High School Diploma
- Enter trades and career vocational training in plumbing, electrical, construction and others.

- Return completed application April 20, 2026, along with your transcript to your High School counselor.
