Below are questions that were submitted by vendors followed by each corresponding answer from WSD.

- 1. Why is the District going out for proposals? We last bid in 2006; just think it is a good idea to occasionally bid services ~ And is the former auditor invited to respond to the RFP? Yes
- 2. Are there any new funds expected in 2023/2024? No new funds, but obviously have received additional state and federal grant dollars
