## Sun Bucks

The summer SNAP benefit is now called SUN Bucks! For families who would like to apply, the application is available online through the following website [MI Bridges](https://newmibridges.michigan.gov). <https://newmibridges.michigan.gov>

### Here is what you need to know:

- Eligible families of school-age children will receive money, per child, to purchase groceries over the summer.
- Families will be automatically enrolled in SUN Bucks if they are already enrolled in SNAP, TANF, or FDPIR benefits or meet the requirements for free or reduced-price school meals.
- Funds will expire 122 days after issuance – so families are encouraged to use them sooner rather than later.
- Families can receive SUN Bucks on top of other nutrition benefits like SNAP and WIC.
