

## GPA: Grade Point Average

- What is it? An average of overall academic performance, usually calculated on a 0-to-4 point scale.
- Why does it matter? Colleges will look at your GPA when they decide to accept you and/or give you scholarship money.
  - Starting with a strong GPA in 9<sup>th</sup> grade helps keep options open for your future
