

The **Waterford School District Transportation Department** would like to welcome back students, parents and staff for the 2023/24 school year.

Bus Stop Information

Bus stop assignments for those who are eligible for transportation services can go to their **MiStar accounts** to review their child's bus stop information in the *Transportation Info* section. Route information will be available at all buildings and a **Transportation Phone Bank** will be available the week of **Aug. 21 – 25, 2023** from **9:00 am to 3:00 pm** to answer any transportation questions. Phone numbers will be (248) 673-0432, (248) 673-9116, and (248) 673-0367. Post Cards will be mailed with bus stop assignments and how to access this information on MiStar.

Transportation Opt-Out Program

New this school year, we will pilot a school bus transportation "opt-out" program. This opt-out is entirely voluntary and we hope to optimize routes, identify stops and allow for more consistent and efficient services by better identifying actual riders.

Bus Stop Guidelines

- REMINDER, after three (3) Days No Call / No Show for any bus stop, the stop will be removed from the route. Bus stops will not be added back until we are contacted by a parent.
- **DO NOT delay the driver at the bus stop.** In addition, it is illegal for any unauthorized individuals to enter the school bus. This is for the safety of all passengers on the bus. Please contact our office (248) 674-2692 for any questions/concerns.

Bus Passes

Bus Passes will not be allowed for the 2023/24 school year until further notice. In addition, please be aware it may necessary to assign riders to a seat on their assigned route to assist with monitoring and supervision.

Bus Rules for Students

As we begin a new school year, we remind all students and parents to be aware of safety procedures around school buses. In addition, you can review our School Bus Safety Video with your child(ren) which includes safe riding tips and an overview of bus rules and proper conduct.

Bus Delay Information Available

Parents, students, and staff have available the latest information about Waterford School District transportation delays via **Blackboard Connect, Comcast Channel 22** (the District's educational cable channel) and the **district's website** at <u>www.waterford.k12.mi.us</u>. Messages will be sent when a bus is delayed 20 minutes or more due to traffic, inclement weather or mechanical difficulties. The message will contain the bus number, route number, and building name.

Parents should have a transportation contingency plan in place so students know what to do in the event of delays.
