

KETTERING HIGH SCHOOL DODGEBALL TOURNAMENT PERMISSION FORM

Dear Parents:

Student Council & Leadership teams are hosting a **dodgeball tournament Friday, February 6, 2026**, during the last part of our school day, as part of our Annual Winter Charity Week. To raise funds, this event will offer students the opportunity to pay to play in the tournament or pay to watch the event in the South Gym. The tournament will begin at 1:00 pm and end at 2:28 pm. Players will be called down for warm-up prior to event start. Since this event is taking place during the school day, players and spectators will miss class. Each Team must have a theme (ex. Lumberjacks) and wear clothes to match the theme.

LOGISTICS

- Up to 12 teams able to participate in the tournament
- Teams will be comprised of 7 players each
- A team is guaranteed a spot once each member has paid their fee, and turned in their permission slip by the deadline
- Each match will be permitted up to 7 minutes play time, the team with the most players left wins
 - Teams that win their match, advance to the next round of the tournament
 - The first place team will play against a team of teachers for first place
- Referees, announcers, and student leaders will assist during the tournament
- **Headshots are NOT allowed - This will result in automatic player disqualification**

Please note that by signing this permission slip, you understand that the Waterford School District Code of Conduct is in place for this event. Any injury or incident will be properly documented. **In order for a team to be complete and set, permission slips and money from each team member must be submitted to the Student Leadership team by the deadline. Teams are required to submit forms and money at the one time. Each team captain should collect completed forms and money and turn in to Mr. Burlingame, Room 105 by the deadline.**

The fee for dodgeball is **\$5 per player**. *All proceeds benefit our Michigan Association of Student Councils & Honors Societies State Charity, Habitat for Humanity - Michigan, to build and preserve affordable homes by bringing people together to create communities and hope, putting love into action, and advocating for everyone to have a decent place to live.*
