MEMBERSHIP POINT INVENTORY

Attending any extra-curricular and/or after school event/activity coordinated by Student Council.

3 points = 1 hour in length | 100 points are required per semester

2 points = Activities during lunches (10 points max per semester)

2 points = Planning and executing a team/group icebreaker

3 points = Attending a Student Council meeting (MANDATORY!)

2 points = Attending a Thursday-morning Student Council meeting

1 point = Wearing a Student Council shirt on meeting days or other special event days

1 point = Dressing for special events (spirit week, etc.)

2 points = Running errands for advisors/ officers

5 points = Working a shift during an annual Blood Drive (3 hour shift or Ghost shift)

6 points = Attending a Student Council training, regional, or state conference

4 points = Presenting at a conference

Extra points may be granted by advisors due to extra work done on committees or other Student Council events.

Captain Pride points (extra) can also be earned by attending other non-Student Council events, but will not be counted towards the 100 point requirement. (Football games, volunteering, etc.)
